

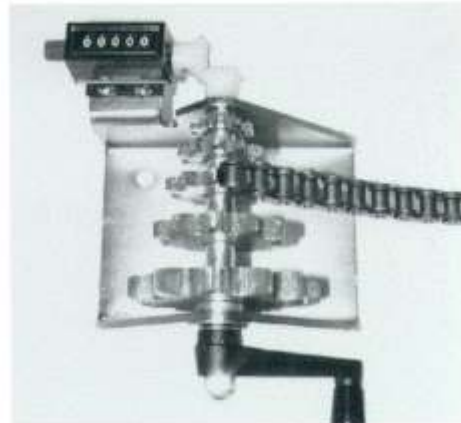
EZ COUNTER®

Counting chain the EZ way - operation instructions

Using the *EZ COUNTER* is simple. Follow the instructions below and see how fast and *EZ* chain link counting has become. The *EZ COUNTER* has sprockets to count 35 — 80 single and double strand, as well as 2040 — 2080 (divide the counter reading by two). Note that 40 and 41 chain are counted on the same sprocket.

STEP 1

Position the chain link as shown with the sprocket tooth pointing straight up. Reset the counter to zero.



STEP 2

Rotate the handle slowly. The counter will read one as the first link is in the position shown. As counting continues, the counter displays the number of the link corresponding to the sprocket tooth pointing straight up. If required, the handle can be rotated in the opposite direction and the counter will subtract.



STEP 3

Double strand chain is positioned over the smaller sprockets as shown and counted in the same manner as single strand chain. Double pitch chain is counted on the corresponding single strand sprocket (2050 uses the 50 sprocket) and the counter reading is divided by two.

Chain can be counted in a number of ways. Remember, when counting links, the finished (cut) chain strand will always be an odd number of pitches. It will have to start with a roller link and end with a roller link. Connector and offset links can be added as required.

The acorn nut on the handle can be tightened to provide more resistance to handle rotation if required. Remember to loosen the allen head set screw slightly. The set screw must be located on the flat in the shaft to positively secure the handle.

Lubricate the shaft with motor oil at both ends where it contacts the base.
