Check the life of your chain



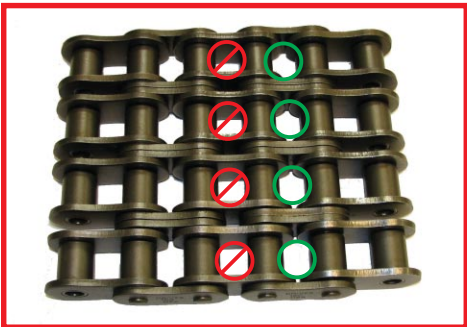
Step 1

Identify chain pitch size.



Step 2

Locate the corresponding step on the gauge.



Step 3

Check gauge for fit between any two roller links. (Perform with chain in tension.)



Step 4

If gauge step fits/goes, chain is worn out and needs to be replaced.

Note: Gauge would be in line, directly below any outside link plate.
